





TEN YEAR OCCUPATIONAL PROJECTIONS

2008-2018, Six County Chicago Region

Economic Modeling Systems, Inc. (EMSI) is a private analytics firm that develops long term job projections for the labor market. Using EMSI data, CWIC analyzed the projected job openings (new jobs + replacement jobs) for the 6 county Chicago region (Cook, Lake, Will, DuPage, Kane, and McHenry). The projections cover the ten year period from 2008-2018, and the data has been updated through Q4 2010.

To the right is the breakdown of projected job openings by major occupational category. EMSI projects 1.7M job openings in the ten year period, which breaks down to an average of 169,693 openings per year. Below are listed the top ten occupations by category.

- Occupations with fewer than 1,000 projected openings over the ten year period were not included.
